FOR AUGUST SCHOOL REGISTRATION. . .

All parents/guardians will again need to provide proof of residency in the Paw Paw School District #271. ***Proof for residents will include a combination of a total of 3 documents, if you already attend Paw Paw Schools, or a total of 4 documents if you are new, (one of these MUST be a valid driver's license with your current address).*** If you are living with someone, the person with whom you are living will have to provide proof of residency, in addition to other documents. A list was included in the May School Bell, which you can look at on our website 2paws.net, and will be available in the August edition of the School Bell. If you do not provide the necessary proof of residency at the August registration, your child's registration will be slowed considerably.
